



VOTER RIGHTS

- ▶ Vote in a private manner without interference.
- ▶ Ask for assistance in marking a ballot.
- ▶ Request written or verbal instructions when voting.
- ▶ Vote a ballot if waiting in line when polls officially close.
- ▶ Correct your ballot. Prior to casting your ballot, you may receive up to two replacement ballots, if you believe you made a mistake. You must cast your third ballot.
- ▶ Vote set aside ballot if your residency, identity, or citizenship status is in question.
- ▶ Report illegal or fraudulent activity to an election officer or to the Secretary of State's Office.
