HOUSE BILL NO. 1580 (Representatives Vetter, Christianson, Dockter, Meier, Motschenbacher, D. Johnston) (Senators Cleary, Cory)

AN ACT to provide for a legislative management study relating to state employee compensation levels.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATE EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION.

- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying the classified state employee total rewards compensation system, including a review of the development and determination of pay grade, classifications, and health care benefits. The study must include a review of:
 - The history of changes to classification and pay grade levels;
 - b. Comparisons among state employees across all departments and between state employee compensation levels to similar private sector jobs;
 - c. The use of equity funding and bonuses to retain employees;
 - d. The payment of prevailing wages on state projects;
 - e. Wage levels in awarding contracts for state projects;
 - f. The impact of changes to health plan benefits; and
 - g. Premium rate structures for single and family coverage and the impact of any proposed changes.
- The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
