SENATE BILL NO. 2196
(Senators Roers, Axtman, Gerhardt)
(Representatives Dobervich, Heinert, Novak)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 15.1-19-16 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to student self-administration of asthma or anaphylaxis medication.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 15.1-19-16 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

3. For purposes of this section, "emergency medication" includes a prescription drug delivered by inhalation to alleviate asthmatic symptoms and ana device that contains a premeasured dose of epinephrine autoinjectable ~~peno~~ to prevent or treat a life-threatening allergic reaction.
